Davos is the highest city in Europe and the largest ski resort in Switzerland. Are you ready to experience all that this winter playground has to offer? With its spectacular scenery, high altitude skiing and descents of over 4,200 feet, Davos certainly offers some of Europe's finest Alpine experiences. By combining a great hotel and a good location, we will be in a perfect position for exploring the vast Davos/Klosters ski region. Imagine five interconnected ski areas spread out on both sides of the valley, more than 50 lifts and 200 miles of marked runs. From Davos, it is also easy to explore surrounding towns and villages by train. A day trip on the Winter Panorama Express train to world-famous St. Moritz is included! The centrally located, 4-star Morosani Posthotel will be our home for the week. From there, it is just a short walk to the Schatzalpbahn or a quick bus ride to the other lift stations. The hotel features a restaurant, a rustic lounge with open fireplace, reading corner, Pöstli Bar, Schneider's Bakery and Chocolate Shop, indoor pool, sauna and steam bath. TOUR DETAILS AND CONDITIONS

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS

A deposit of \$500 per person is due to hold your place on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will be sent an invoice and "Know Before You Go" information kit. A second deposit of \$500 per person is due on **October 1, 2000**. Final payment is due on **December 1, 2000**. Your place may be cancelled if payments are not received on time.

PRICING

The Ski Switzerland package is based on a minimum group size of 20 participants. Should the group size fall between 15 and 19 people, the package price will increase by \$100 per person. The Germany Extension package is based on a minimum group size of 15 participants. Should the group size fall between 10 and 14 people, the package price will increase by \$50 per person. Package price is subject to change due to airfare fuel surcharges, currency devaluation, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. Tour is priced on exchange rates in effect as of April 1, 2000. Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. *All prices reflect a cash or check discount.* For payments by Visa, MasterCard or American Express, add 3%.

Land Only: \$1342 per person, double occupancy.

EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION

The U.S. dollar is currently enjoying an extremely favorable exchange rate with the European currencies and the Eurodollar. The pricing of this package reflects the strong value of the dollar. Forecasts indicate that the U.S. dollar will remain strong. However, in the event of a significant drop in the dollar's value, a surcharge will be applied to your package price.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS

Group space in Tourist Class has been booked on SAS from Seattle for this departure. Departures from other cities or connecting flights are available, usually at a carrier add-on surcharge. Frequent flyer award holders can book their own air arrangements. You are responsible for arriving and departing at the same time as the group in order to use the group transfers. Unused transfers are non-refundable. Upgrades to Business Class are available. Ask for details. Airfares are subject to change by the airline for fuel and tax-related reasons.

HOTEL ROOM DESCRIPTIONS - IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ!!!

There are three room types available at the Morosani Posthotel. Please specify your preference when you send in your deposit. Rooms will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, and you will be advised of the room type that has been confirmed for you. The package price is based on standard double rooms, north-facing. For an additional \$50 per person, you can upgrade to a superior double room, south-facing with balcony. A limited number of junior suites are available for an additional \$142 per person.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

Single rooms are limited and available on a first-come basis. For the Ski Switzerland Week Only, add \$100. For the Germany Extension, add \$150.

DEVIATIONS AND EXTENSIONS

Deviations and extensions are allowed. In addition to any airfare increases/fees and extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 will be charged by All Mountain Vacations. Any unused portions of original package are non-refundable. Deviation and extension requests must be submitted prior to **December 20, 1999**. Once deviation itinerary has been confirmed, any subsequent changes will each be charged a \$35 fee, plus any additional air and land costs.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellation fees of \$500 per person apply prior to October 1, 2000. From Oct. 1 – Nov. 30, forfeit \$1000 per person. Total land costs plus any airline charges are forfeited from December 1 to departure. *Trip protection insurance is highly recommended.*

TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE

Travel worry-free with Travel Guard Cancellation and Interruption Insurance. For only \$157 (Ski Pkg Only) or \$197 (Ski Pkg + Extension) per person, you will receive a comprehensive insurance package that includes the following benefits: full reimbursement of all non-refundable expenses due to cancellation for medical reasons; \$10,000 medical expense; \$20,000 emergency assistance; \$1000 lost baggage allowance, and more. All baggage is carried at owner's risk. It is up to passenger to make claims with the insurance company. Insurance should be purchased with initial deposit for full value protection. Please be sure that you are adequately covered in case of accident, injury or illness during the trip. **Pre-Existing Medical Conditions Exclusion Waived, if policy purchased within 7 days of initial trip deposit.** For complete coverage details, ask for Travel Guard brochure.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

U.S. and Canadian citizens require a valid passport. Non-citizens should consult their consulate.

BAGGAGE

Normal baggage allowance is 2 pieces per person, not to exceed 70 lbs. each. A skier on an international flight is allowed to substitute 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag for one of the suitcases, for a total of three pieces of checked luggage. In addition, 1 carry-on bag is allowed with a max. weight of 18 lbs. and max. dimensions of 20x16x10 in. Carry-on baggage must fit under seat or in overhead bin. Excess baggage fee may cost \$110 minimum each way per bag.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS

Seats are assigned on a first booked and request basis. Carriers will do their best to honor all requests.

MILEAGE CREDIT

Mileage credit may be earned for your flights. You must be a member before checking in for the flight, and you must submit your mileage account number at check-in.

TOUR ESCORT

Tour is escorted but not necessarily on all flights. Your escort's primary concern is the welfare of the group. He will assist in tour-related and individual problems, but not at the expense of the group needs.

NOT INCLUDED

Lift passes, ski guides, meals not specified, portage at hotels, beverages at meals, tips to porters, drivers, hotel staff, or guides, items of a personal nature and *air taxes of approximately \$70 per person.*

TIPPING

It is customary to tip for good service received from bus drivers, guides, waitstaff and chambermaids at the end of your stay. Your tour escort will make suggestions and discuss details.
