Ski the Arlberg during the 2001 Alpine Ski World Championships!

Our journey begins with a comfortable evening flight on SAS from Seattle or Newark to Copenhagen, with a connecting flight to Munich the next day. We'll spend our first night in **Munich**, giving us time to visit such sights as the Frauenkirche, Munich's most visible landmark; Hofbräuhaus, the world's most famous brewery; and the Glockenspiel at Town Hall.

If you want to indulge yourself, pamper yourself and rub shoulders with nobility, **Lech** is for you! This glamorous resort is also one of the most picturesque villages in the Alps with a history dating back to the 12th century. The famous Arlberg region of the Austrian Alps offers 160 miles of prepared runs, 110 miles of off-piste (ungroomed) runs, 85 lifts and 4,900 feet of vertical drop, all on the same lift pass! From Lech, we can easily ski the nearby resorts of St. Anton, Zürs, St. Christoph and Stuben. Begin your day in Lech, ski to **Zürs** for lunch, sip a schnapps in the car-free hamlet of **Oberlech**, and return to Lech for an abundance of après-ski activities. Or take the bus to **St. Anton**, ski to **St. Christoph** for a glass of glühwein, schuss down to **Stuben** in the afternoon, and still make it back to Lech for dinner. We are lucky to be in Lech when the **2001 Alpine Ski World Championships** are being held in St. Anton! We can't guarantee you'll meet Hermann "the Terminator" Maier, but you never know. Tickets are available if you would like to attend any of the races or ceremonies.

Our home for the week will be the elegant 4-star Hotel Berghof. Centrally located and less than a two-minute walk to the lifts, the hotel features a spacious lobby and bar with open fireplace, restaurant, sauna, steamroom, dipping pool and billiards room.

TOUR DETAILS AND CONDITIONS

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS

A deposit of \$500 per person is due to hold your place on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will be sent an invoice and a "Know Before You Go" information kit. A second deposit of \$500 per person is due on **October 2, 2000**. Final payment is due on **December 15, 2000**. See *Trip Protection Insurance section below*.

PRICING

This package is based on a minimum group size of 20 participants. Should the group size fall between 15 and 19 people, the package price will increase by \$75 per person to cover increased transfer costs. Package price is subject to change due to airfare fuel surcharges, currency devaluation, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. Tour is priced on exchange rates in effect as of April 1, 2000. Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. *All prices reflect a cash or check discount.* For further payments by Visa, MasterCard or American Express, add 3% to the balance due.

Land Only: \$1900 (Std) or \$2100 (Sup) per person, double occupancy.

EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION

The U.S. dollar is currently enjoying an extremely favorable exchange rate with the European currencies and the Eurodollar. The pricing of this package reflects the strong value of the dollar. Forecasts indicate that the U.S. dollar will remain strong. However, in the event of a significant drop on the dollar's value, a surcharge will be applied to your package price.

HOTEL ROOM DESCRIPTIONS - IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ!!!

There are two room types available at the Hotel Berghof. Please specify your preference when you send in your deposit. Rooms will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, and you will be advised of the room type that has been confirmed for you. The package price is based on standard double rooms, type "Arlberg." For an additional \$200 per person, you can upgrade to a superior double room, type "Omeshorn." These rooms are much larger than the standard double rooms and have a separate sitting area and balcony.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

Single rooms are limited and available on a first-come basis. Choose from two room types. For a standard single room, type "Karhorn," add \$250 to the package price. The Karhorn rooms are typical European single rooms with one twin bed. If you would like a larger room with a bigger bed, select the type "Arlberg" double room for single use by adding \$600 to package price.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS - Group space in Tourist Class has been booked on SAS from Seattle for this departure. Departures from other cities or connecting flights are available, usually at a carrier add-on surcharge. Frequent flyer award holders should book their own air arrangements. You are responsible for arriving and departing at the same time as the group in order to use the group transfers. Unused transfers are non-refundable. Upgrades to Business Class are available. Ask for details. Airfares are subject to change by the airline for fuel and tax-related reasons

DEVIATIONS AND EXTENSIONS

Deviations and extensions are allowed. In addition to any airfare increases/fees and extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 will be charged by All Mountain Vacations. Any unused portions of original package are non-refundable. Deviation and extension requests must be submitted prior to **December 1, 2000**. Any subsequent changes will each be charged a \$35 fee, plus any additional air and land costs.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellation fees of \$500 per person apply prior to October 2, 2000. From Oct. 2 - Dec. 14, forfeit \$1000 per person. Total land costs plus any airline charges are forfeited from December 15 to departure. If a replacement can be found prior to the airline tickets being issued, cancellation penalties may be reduced. *Trip protection insurance is highly recommended. SEE BELOW.*

TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE

Travel worry-free with Travel Guard Cancellation and Interruption Insurance. For \$197 per person, you will receive a comprehensive insurance package that includes the following benefits: full reimbursement of all trip costs if cancelled or interrupted for a medical reason; \$10,000 medical expense; \$20,000 emergency assistance; \$1000 lost baggage allowance, and more. All baggage is carried at owner's risk. It is up to the passenger to make claims with the insurance company. Insurance should be purchased with initial deposit for full value protection. Please be sure that you are adequately covered in case of accident, injury or illness during the trip. Pre-Existing Medical Conditions Exclusion waived, if policy purchased within 7 days of initial trip deposit. *For full coverage details, please ask for a Travel Guard brochure.*

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

U.S. and Canadian citizens require a valid passport. Non-citizens should consult their consulate.

BAGGAGE

Normal baggage allowance is 2 pieces per person, not to exceed 70 lbs. each. A skier on an international flight is allowed to substitute 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag for one of the suitcases, for a total of three pieces of checked luggage. In addition, 1 carry-on bag is allowed with a max. weight of 18 lbs. and max. dimensions of 20x16x10 in. Carry-on baggage must fit under seat or in overhead bin. Excess baggage fee may cost \$110 minimum each way per bag.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS

Seats are assigned on a first booked and request basis. Carriers will do their best to honor all requests. All flights are non-smoking.

MILEAGE CREDIT

Mileage credit may be earned for your flights. You must be a member before checking in for the flight, and you must submit your mileage account number at check-in.

TOUR ESCORT

Tour is escorted, but not necessarily on all flights. Your escort's primary concern is the welfare of the group. He will assist in tour-related and individual problems, but not at the expense of the group needs.

NOT INCLUDED

Lift passes, ski guides, meals not specified, portage at hotels, beverages at meals, tips to porters, drivers, hotel staff, or guides, items of a personal nature and airport taxes of approx. \$70 per person.

TIPPING

It is customary to tip for good service received from porters, drivers, guides, waitstaff and chambermaids at the end of your stay. Your tour escort will make suggestions and discuss details.
