Sölden and the spectacular Ötztal Arena of resorts has come of age with introduction of the new "Golden Gate" ski lifts, that now serve one of Europe's highest glacier ski regions. For 5300 years, Ötzi the Similaun Iceman, hid on the Austrian/Italian border, Hauslabjoch that is located above our resort. His preservation is due to the dry high altitude snow and ice of the Ötztal , that now provides our guarantee for perfect skiing on slopes to match all tastes. This region of Austria has long been an international winter sports destination but only within the last year has it reached its full potential. The areas of Sölden , HochSölden & Längenfeld will more than keep us busy each day exploring new terrain and runs up to 10 kilometers long. (That's 5,515 vertical feet) Obergurgl & Hochgurgl our next door neighbors will even double our mega miles of ski terrain!

Our Hotel Tirolerhof lies in the heart of Sölden at 4,518 feet and is very close to the main cable cars to Hochsölden and Gigijoch. Tirolean hospitality in its finest form awaits our group as we are pampered with four course dinners and Ötztal farmhouse breakfasts each day. The Tirolerhof is a First Class hotel in every detail from your room décor to the well laid out health and fitness center complete with sauna, solarium, steam bath and massage. As you ski from the slopes to our hotel door in the afternoon, you will be looking forward to an evening of fun and relaxation at the family Falkner's well-appointed hotel establishment.

During our week in the Ötztal, there will be plenty to keep winter sports and sightseeing buffs happy and occupied. Winter hiking footpaths, shopping, trips to the mountaintop restaurant vistas, local entertainment, and a multitude of health & sports activities await you. The Inn Valley is only a half hour away for day trip sightseeing to Innsbruck and environs.

Our group will travel via Innsbruck to the slopes of Kitzbühel for a last full day cruising its vast ski circus and enjoying this wonderful Austrian ski mecca. TOUR DETAILS AND CONDITIONS

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS - A deposit of \$400 per person is due to hold your place on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will be sent an invoice and "Know Before You Go" information kit. Final payment due no later than **December 30, 2000**.

PRICING - All prices are per person, in USD, based on double occupancy. The package price is based on a minimum group size of 20 participants. Should the group size fall between 15 and 19 people, Tour A price could increase by \$50 per person. Tour B is based on 10 participants. Should the group size fall below 10 people, this portion could cancel or a surcharge would apply. Package price is subject to change due to airfare fuel surcharges, currency devaluation, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. **Tour is priced on exchange rates in effect as of May 1, 2000.** Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. **All tour prices reflect a cash or check discount. For payments by Visa, Mastercard or American Express, add 3%.**

Land Only: On request.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT - A few single rooms are available on a first-come basis. Add \$196 for Tour A & \$110 for Tour B extension.

EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION - The U.S. dollar is currently enjoying an extremely favorable exchange rate with the European currencies and Eurodollar. The price of this package reflects the dollar's strong value. Forecasts indicate that the U.S. dollar will remain strong. If the dollar's value drops significantly, a surcharge may be applied to the package price.

HOTEL ROOM DESCRIPTIONS - Tyrolean décor comfortable double rooms with bath at the Hotel Tyrolerhof in Sölden. Room location will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Our hotel is a 4-star centrally located hotel providing a health spa facility with sauna & steam bath, cozy bar and lounge, restaurant, and rooms including satellite TV, telephone/radio/clock. Buffet breakfast & 4-course dinner are served daily. Our Hotel in Salzburg is 4-star and includes buffet breakfast. Our Hotel in Cesky Krumlov is a quaint 4-star Hotel Ruze including breakfast and dinner at nearby restaurant. Our Hotel Adria in Prague is 4-star and includes breakfast each day and one typical beer hall dinner and one formal dinner arrangement.

DEVIATIONS AND EXTENSIONS - Deviations and extensions are allowed. In addition to any airfare increases/fees and extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 will be charged by All Mountain Vacations. Any unused portions of original package are non-refundable. **Requests must be submitted prior to December 1, 2000.** Once deviation itinerary has been confirmed, any new changes will be charged a \$35 fee per each invoice, plus any additional air and land costs for new arrangements.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS - All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellation fees of \$200 per person apply prior to September 1, 2000. From Sep. 1 - Dec. 30, forfeit \$400 per person. Total land costs plus any airline charges are forfeited from December 31 to departure unless replacement is found. **Trip protection insurance is highly recommended.**

TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE - Travel worry-free with Travel Guard Cancellation and Interruption Insurance. For only \$154 per person (Tour A) or \$194 per person (Tour B) you will receive a comprehensive insurance package that includes the following benefits: full reimbursement of covered non-refundable payments due to cancellation for a medical reason; \$10,000 medical expense; \$20,000 emergency assistance; \$1000 lost baggage allowance, and more. All baggage is carried at owner's risk. It is up to the passenger to make claims with the insurance company. Insurance should be purchased with initial deposit for full value protection. Please be sure that you are adequately covered in case of accident, injury or illness during the trip. **Pre-Existing Medical Conditions Exclusion waived, if policy purchased within 7 days of initial trip deposit. For full coverage details, please ask for a Travel Guard brochure.**

AIR ARRANGEMENTS - Group space in Tourist Class has been blocked on SAS from Seattle for this departure. Departures from other cities or connecting flights are available, usually at a carrier add-on surcharge. Frequent flyer award holders can book their own air arrangements. You are responsible for arriving and departing at the same time as the group in order to use the group transfers. Unused transfers are non-refundable. Upgrades to Business Class are available. Ask for details. Airfares are subject to change by the airline for fuel and tax-related reasons.

BAGGAGE - Normal baggage allowance is 2 pieces per person, not to exceed 70 lbs. each. A skier on an international flight is allowed to substitute 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag for one of the suitcases, for a total of three pieces of checked luggage. In addition, 1 carry-on bag is allowed with a max. weight of 18 lbs. and max. dimensions of 20x16x10 in. Carry-on baggage must fit under seat or in overhead bin. Excess baggage fee may cost approx. \$110 minimum each way per bag.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS - Seats are assigned on a first booked and request basis. All flights are non-smoking.

MILEAGE CREDIT - Mileage credit may be earned for your flights. You must be a member before checking in for the flight, and you must submit your mileage account number at check-in.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS - U.S. and Canadian citizens require a valid passport. Non-citizens should consult their consulate.

TOUR ESCORT - Tour is escorted but not necessarily on all flights. Your group escort's primary concern is the welfare of the group. He will assist in tour-related and individual problems, but not at the expense of the group.

NOT INCLUDED IN TOUR PRICE - Lift passes, meals not specified, beverages at meals, tips to porters, drivers, hotel staff, or guides, items of a personal nature, and *airport taxes of approximately \$70 per person.*

TIPPING - If you have received good service, it is customary to tip bus drivers and guides, waitstaff and chambermaids at the end of your stay. Your tour escort will discuss details.

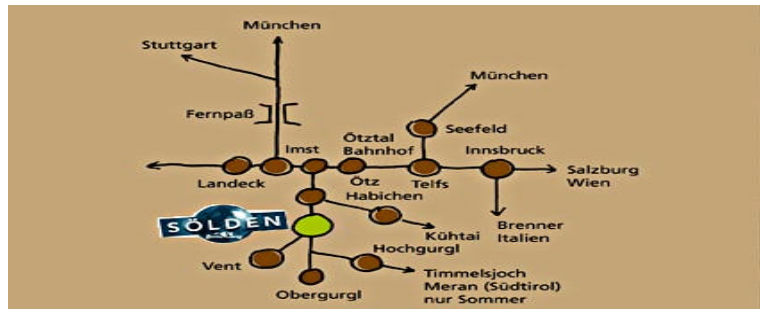
