### Mayrhofen, Austria

Mayrhofen is a small town nestled in the Ziller Valley and surrounded by the steep mountains of the Austrian Alps. Known for its beauty and warm Tyrolean hospitality, this friendly village and its inhabitants will ensure that your vacation is an unforgettable experience both on and off the slopes. The vast region of Mayrhofen and the Ziller Valley includes over 150 lifts, with vertical drops of up to 4,500 feet, terrain for beginners to experts, and numerous on-slope restaurants and bars. Mayrhofen itself consists of three main ski areas: the Penkenjoch, the Horberg-Gerent, and the Ahorn. A new gondola ensures a speedy ascent from the village center to the top of the Penken area. The other two areas are accessible by using the free shuttle bus. In addition, it is possible to travel on local trains and buses to visit other nearby ski resorts. At the head of the valley is the pretty resort of Hintertux, lying at the foot of the glacier. With the base of the resort at 4,920 feet and the height of the top lift station at 10,693 feet, excellent snow conditions are the norm. The Zillertal Super Ski Pass covers all ski areas in the Valley, including train and bus transportation between the resorts.

If you decide to take a few days off from the slopes, you'll enjoy exploring Mayrhofen and the surrounding villages in the valley. In addition, sightseeing excursions are available to Innsbruck and the Swarovski Crystal World Museum, Salzburg, Kitzbühel and Vipiteno, Italy. For non-skiers, a Pedestrian Pass is available, allowing access to several miles of winter walking paths, spectacular views and many on-slope restaurants. The elegant, yet cozy Hotel Neue Post will be your home for the week. This First Class hotel is located in the center of the village, and its friendly Tyrolean atmosphere is sure to charm you. Hotel features include a restaurant, bar (with daily après-ski dancing) and a large spa area with Finnish sauna, steam bath, and whirlpool.

### Munich, Germany

Experience some of Europe's history and culture after your week in the Alps. Visit such sights as the Frauenkirche, Munich's most visible landmark; Hofbräuhaus, the world's most famous brewery; and the Glockenspiel at Town Hall. We'll be staying at the centrally located, 4-star King's Classic Hotel.

## TOUR DETAILS AND CONDITIONS

### DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS

A deposit of \$300 per person is due to hold your place on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will receive an invoice and "Know Before You Go" information kit. Final payment is due **December 1, 2000**. Your place may be cancelled if payments are not received on time.

### PRICING

The package price is based on a minimum group size of 15 participants. Should the group size fall between 10 and 14 people, package price will increase by \$75 per person. If fewer than 10 people, the package price will remain the same, but the trip may not be escorted. Package prices are subject to change due to airfare fuel surcharges, currency devaluations, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. Tour is priced on exchange rates in effect as of May 1, 2000. Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. All prices reflect a cash or check discount. For payments by Visa, Mastercard or American Express, add 3%.

**Land only:** \$870 per person, double occupancy.

### SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

Single rooms are very limited and available on request only. For the Ski Package Only, add \$150 to package price. For the Munich Extension, add \$69 to package price. A typical single room in a European hotel is small and contains one twin bed.

### EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION

The U.S. dollar is currently enjoying an extremely favorable exchange rate with the European currencies and the Eurodollar. The pricing of this package reflects the strong value of the dollar. Forecasts indicate that the U.S. dollar will remain strong. However, in the event of a significant drop in the dollar's value, a surcharge will be applied to your package price.

### AIR ARRANGEMENTS

Group space in Tourist Class has been booked on SAS from Seattle for this departure. Departures from other cities or connecting flights are available, usually at a carrier add-on surcharge. Frequent flyer award holders can book their own air arrangements. You are responsible for arriving and departing at the same time as the group in order to use the group transfers. Unused transfers are non-refundable. Upgrades to Business Class are available. Ask for details. Airfares are subject to change by the airline for fuel and tax-related reasons.

### DEVIATIONS AND EXTENSIONS

Deviations and extensions are allowed. In addition to any airfare increases/fees and extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 will be charged by All Mountain Vacations. Any unused portions of original package are non-refundable. Deviation and extension requests must be submitted prior to **November 20, 2000**. Once deviation itinerary has been confirmed, any subsequent changes will each be charged a \$35 fee, plus any additional air and land costs.

### CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellation fees of \$100 per person apply prior to Sep. 1, 2000, unless a replacement can be found. The \$25 initial booking fee is non-refundable. From Sep. 1 - Nov. 30, forfeit \$300 per person, unless a replacement can be found. If a replacement is found, forfeit only \$100. Total land costs plus any airline charges are forfeited from December 1 to departure. *Trip protection insurance is highly recommended.*

### TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE

Travel worry-free with Travel Guard Cancellation and Interruption Insurance. For only \$112 (Ski Pkg Only) or \$157 (Ski Pkg PLUS Extension) per person, you will receive a comprehensive insurance package that includes the following benefits: full reimbursement of all non-refundable expenses due to cancellation for a medical reason; \$10,000 medical expense; \$20,000 emergency assistance; \$1000 lost baggage allowance, and more. All baggage is carried at owner's risk. It is up to the passenger to make claims with the insurance company. Insurance should be purchased with deposit or final invoice for full value protection. ### PASSPORTS AND VISAS

### BAGGAGE

Normal baggage allowance is 2 pieces per person, not to exceed 70 lbs each. A skier on an international flight is allowed to substitute 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag for one of the suitcases, for a total of three pieces of checked luggage. In addition, 1 carry-on bag is allowed with a max. weight of 18 lbs. and max. dimensions of 20x16x10 in. Carry-on baggage must fit under seat or in overhead bin. Excess baggage fee may cost \$110 minimum each way per bag.

### SEAT ASSIGNMENTS

Seats are assigned on a first booked and request basis. The airlines will do their best to honor all requests.

### MILEAGE CREDIT

Mileage credit may be earned for your flights. You must be a member before checking in for the flight, and you must submit your mileage account number at check-in.

### TOUR ESCORT

Tour is escorted but not necessarily on all flights. Your escort's primary concern is the welfare of the group. He will assist in tour-related and individual problems, but not at the expense of the group needs.

### NOT INCLUDED

Lift passes, meals not specified, portage at hotels, beverages at meals, tips to porters, drivers, hotel staff, or guides, items of a personal nature, and **airport taxes of approximately \$70 per person.**

### TIPPING

If you have received good service, it is customary to tip bus drivers, waitstaff and chambermaids at the end of your stay. Your tour escort will offer suggestions and discuss details.
