



Mountain bike through the Austrian Alps Guided 7-day biking tour

Tours through the most scenic country of the Alps—TYROL

Day 01, Sunday - Arrive in Steinberg, Tyrol Minibus transfer from Munich Airport to Steinberg.

At 06.00 pm the team will welcome you and inform about the details of your week.

Day 02, Monday - Tyrol's Rose Garden . Elevation Gain 400 m, Distance: 18 km, approx. 04 hours. We begin our day directly from the Lodge, our journey leads us past creeks and Alms to the scenic "Schmalzklause". High above us we can view the majestic peaks of the Rofan mountains, we relax as we roll down the trail that follows the "Bachvalley".

Day 03, Tuesday - The Vital Route. Elevation Gain 600 m, Distance 30 km, approx. 05 hours

We follow the Vital Route as we bike to the end of the "Schönjochvalley" after a brief steep part we reach the "Kögeljoch" which opens a fascinating view of the Lake Achen, Tyrol's largest mountain lake. Following a healthy snack we speed down into the valley and follow the panorama train that follows the banks of the lake.

Day 04, Wednesday -The highest Alms of Tyrol. Elevation Gain 800 m, Distance 31 km, approx. 06 hours. We bike along the pleasant trail to the Kaiserhouse, the residence of the former emperor of Austria. Our day continues as we bike into the "Stallenbachvalley" with the power of nature as its releases the water crashes down the creeks through the steep rock formations. We reach the "Ackernalm", a traditional Tyrolean hut. Get together with your new friends, drink some fresh milk and sing along with locals as we enjoy our night in peace here at 1.383 m.

Day 05, Thursday - The Guffert Hut. Elevation Gain 800 m, Distance 17km, approx. 05 hours

We begin our day with an relaxing downhill trail along the Brandenberger Ache. This remote trail is hardly travelled and we will keep our eyes open for the abundant wildlife. The journey continues over ancient trails that lead us past remote peaks surrounding the Rofan range.

Day 06, Friday -The oldest scriptures of Tyrol. Elevation Gain 100 m, Distance 14km, approx. 02 hours Following a brief hike we reach the worlds famous cliffs that contain the "Rätischen Inschriften" – the oldest scriptures of Tyrol. An additional highlight of today's journey is the ride back into the valley. We pass the small Creeks and view the different rock formation that nature created over the years. We reach our lodge where we will enjoy a relaxing evening together.

Day 07, Saturday - Via minibus to Munich APT

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS

A \$150 per person deposit is due to confirm your space on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will receive an invoice and "Know Before You Go" information kit. Once your package is confirmed, a 30% deposit per person will be due within 7 to 10 days. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure, unless otherwise advised. Your space may be cancelled if payments are not received on time.

PRICING & EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION

Package price is based on a group of 20 participants and is subject to change due to currency devaluations, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. Tour is priced on current exchange rates. Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. In case of human or computer billing error, All Mountain Vacations reserves the right to reinvoice for the correct amount. *All prices reflect a 4% cash or check discount.* Visa, MasterCard and American Express are accepted at non-discounted prices.
