



BIKE THE ROMANTIC ROAD From Innsbruck to Donauwörth

Self-Guided 8-day hiking tour
April 30-Sept. 10, 2006 (Weekly)

No citizen in the Middle Ages would have imagined that this road will become one of the most important holiday pathways in the future. The old trade route preserved its historical image and its romantic atmosphere throughout the ages. The episcopal and the royal residence and the fairy tale Bavarian castles provide the surroundings for a relaxing bicycle tour!

Course features: Along the Lech on bicycle paths and small country roads, through quiet and charming landscapes near the Roman road. A bicycle tour for everybody. From Imst/Hahntenjoch 2000 m (transfer) to Donauwörth 400 m continuously downhill with short hilly passages. Approx. 300 km.

Day 01, Sunday—Arrival to Innsbruck. In the evening tour information and issue of rental bikes at your hotel. Dinner and overnight at Innsbruck hotel.

Day 02, Monday Innsbruck - Imst (approx. 65 km) - On the former Treidelweg (Treidel path) along the Inn and through small villages (churches worth seeing, old aristocratic houses, fortress ruins) to Stams (baroque Cistercian convent, convent museum) on through Haiming to Imst. Day 03, Tuesday—Imst - Füssen (approx. 40-55 km) To Hahntenjoch (200m) by bus, via the "Fernpaß". A wonderful downhill ride to Elmen and Lech follows. The splendid mountain landscape, the mountain river and the town of Reutte get you into the right mood for a dream journey. The city of Füssen surrounded by magnificent peaks of the Alps and blue-green mountain lakes invites you for a stroll around the city (pedestrian zone, you see the outline of the Via Claudia).

Day 04, Wednesday—Füssen - Schongau (approx. 45 km) - King Ludwig's II fairy tale castles in Königswinkel – Hohenschwangau and Neuschwanstein – and at the valley station of the Tegelberg you should see the uncovered Roman thermal springs. The world famous Wieskirche (church) – the epitome of Bavarian rococo – is the next highlight. Through Steingaden and Peiting you will experience the highlights of the landscape and will arrive in Schongau filled with good impressions.

Day 05, Thursday—Schongau – Landsberg/Lech (approx. 40 km) Schongau – former Bavarian boarder fortress – with fortified passages on the town wall that can still be accessed – gives evidence of the past. The splendid view over the Lech Valley promises greatness. Old part of town (Romanesque basilica with vaults), Hohenfurch, Epfach (the Roman Abodiacum, Roman museum) and Vilgertshofen (baroque pilgrimage church) are the places of interest before you reach Landsberg.

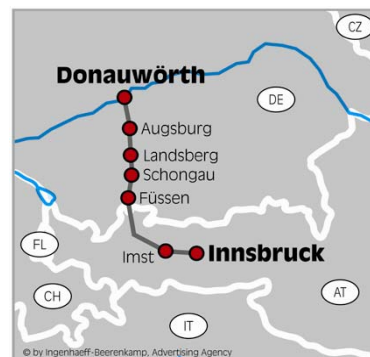
Day 06, Friday—Landsberg/Lech – Augsburg (approx. 50 km) You should see the medieval city centre of Landsberg/Lech – embedded in a wild romantic river bed of the river with the same name – the historic town hall and the Gothic Bavarian gate. Through Kaufering am Lech to Königsbrunn (with the 11 km long, best preserved part of the Via Claudia), into the old Bavarian duke city of Friedberg and on to the Fugger City of Augsburg. Numerous historic monuments from all epochs give the city its distinctive tone. The Roman museum is worth seeing.

Day 07, Saturday—Augsburg – Donauwörth (approx. 50 km) - On along the Lech canal to the pilgrimage town Biberbach and through meadow landscapes and Mertingen (Roman citadel Burghöfe) to today's destination. The former free imperial city of Donauwörth offers an abundance of places of interest. (Mangoldfelsen, archaeological museum and the Käthe-Kruse puppet museum). The glorious imperial road with its stately bourgeois houses invite you to a stroll in town.

Day 08, Sunday—Donauwörth—After breakfast – Individual departure.

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS

A \$150 per person deposit is due to confirm your space on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will receive an invoice and "Know Before You Go" information kit. Once your package is confirmed, a 30% deposit per person will be due within 7 to 10 days. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure, unless otherwise advised. Your space may be cancelled if payments are not received on time.

PRICING & EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION

Package price is based on staying at a 3* hotel. Half board can be requested at a surcharge of \$166. A 3 & 4* combination is also available for \$ 764 with half board optional add-on for \$187. Prices are subject to change due to currency devaluations, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. Tour is priced on current exchange rates. Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. In case of human or computer billing error, All Mountain Vacations reserves the right to reinvoice for the correct amount. **All prices reflect a 4% cash or check discount.** Visa, MasterCard and American Express are accepted at non-discounted prices.

Single supplement: Add \$166 to 3* package price and \$209 for the combo 3-4* package. Please note that European single rooms are typically quite small and contain one twin bed. Single rooms are very limited and on request only.

Deviations and extensions are allowed. In addition to any extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 will be charged by All Mountain Vacations.
