Courmayeur, The Pearl of the Alps, is snuggled at the end of Italy's Aosta Valley that towered over by the majestic scenery of the Mont Blanc mountain chain. It is perhaps, the most famous and certainly the oldest Italian alpine resort. Courmayeur has become one of the most important ski resorts in the world, knowing how to combine its spectacular ski trails with rare glamour, making it a magical and exclusive place. It is approximately an hour's drive from Turin, site of the 2006 Olympic Games. An extended tour option will offer the chance to ski the Olympic resorts and explore this fascinating city.

This alpine village is more than just a little bit special. It has an atmosphere of easy going friendliness that is rare in this fast lane society. On weekends, and holiday seasons, Courmayeur takes on a distinctly Italian persona. During these periods, the narrow streets of the grand old village are alive with fur coats, grand fashion, and the Italian's greeting "Ciao Bella". The village provides a cozy atmosphere with narrow cobblestone streets, small bars and fabulous restaurants. For skiing, the slopes are reached by cable cars stretching across the valley, and the short return to town is by bus. During recent years the resort has invested heavily in snowmaking to ensure good snow conditions on the Val Veny side of the resort. Its star quality's are found in the restaurants, where Italians seem to spend far more time than on the slopes. Skiing is as you like it. Lots of well groomed easy runs for cruisers, high mountain and bumpy black runs for better skiers and plenty of off piste powder runs on its high slopes. This is an active town with plenty of Après ski, disco 'til dawn, or sit back and sip some local wine.

The **Hotel Cresta et Duc** is a family run hotel well known for its good food and friendly staff, situated in a central and panoramic position just 200 metres from the cable-car. We will have a welcome cocktail in the tavern, candle light dinners with typical Aostan dinners and enjoy the piano bar and live music in the evenings. One evening the hotel provides free transfer to the St. Vincent Casino for those wishing to sample European gambling. All rooms have bath, cable TV, mini bar, telephone and hair dryer. Many AMV guests request returns to this hotel. Plan on joining this fun loving group for a great time in Italy!

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENTS

A \$150 booking fee is due to confirm a spot on this tour. Upon receipt, you will receive an invoice, a "Know Before You Go" information kit and a request for a deposit of \$300 per person. *Final payment is due DEC 04, 2006.*

Price from your home gateway can be quoted upon request.

The package price is based on Star Alliance group or contract air fares in Tourist Class for airfare. Group space is blocked from Seattle and from other gateways will be booked as you request space with your deposit. The tour is guaranteed to operate no matter how many are booked but could have a supplement for transfers should the tour participants fall below 18. *All prices reflect a 4.5% cash or check discount.* Visa, MasterCard or American Express are accepted at non-discounted prices.

SAS ECONOMY EXTRA

Upgrades to SAS Economy Extra are available for \$470 each polar direction. This special section of the aircraft has larger seats and extra leg room .

LAND ONLY PRICE

For travelers arranging own air transportation deduct \$476 from West Coast air/land price. It will be your responsibility to arrive Torino in time for transfers. There is no deduction for unused transfers.

CHANGE RATE INFORMATION

DEVIATIONS AND EXTENSIONS

Deviations and extensions are allowed. In addition to any airfare increases/fees and extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 will be charged by All Mountain Vacations. Air France charges an additional fee. Any unused portions of original package are non-refundable. Deviation and extension requests must be submitted to All Mountain Vacations prior to November 06th please. Once deviation itinerary has been confirmed, any subsequent changes will each be charged a \$35 fee, plus any additional air and land costs.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

All cancellations must be received in writing. Payments must be considered non-refundable unless refunds can be obtained from vendors. *Trip insurance is recommended.* In any event, a minimum of \$150 is non-refundable. Once final documents are issued all payments are considered non-refundable.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

U.S. and Canadian citizens require a valid passport. Non-citizens should consult their consulate.

BAGGAGE

Normal baggage allowance is 2 pieces per person, not to exceed 50 lbs. each. A skier on an international flight is allowed to substitute 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag for one of the suitcases, for a total of three pieces of checked luggage. In addition, 1 carry-on bag is allowed with a max. weight of 26 lbs. and max. dimensions of 20x15x10 in. Carry-on baggage must fit under seat or in overhead compartment. Excess baggage fees may cost over \$110 each way per bag. Baggage allowance can also vary air carrier. We suggest you use the new rolling ski bags with the boot compartments for ease of use and to

assist keeping you within limits.

NOT INCLUDED

Lift passes, meals not specified, portorage at hotels, beverages at meals, tips to porters, drivers, hotel and restaurant staff, or guides, items of a personal nature, and **air taxes/fuel charges of approximately \$300 per person are not included in the tour cost.**

TIPPING

It is customary to tip bus drivers, guides, wait staff and chambermaids at the end of your stay. We will provide more details in your tour documents.

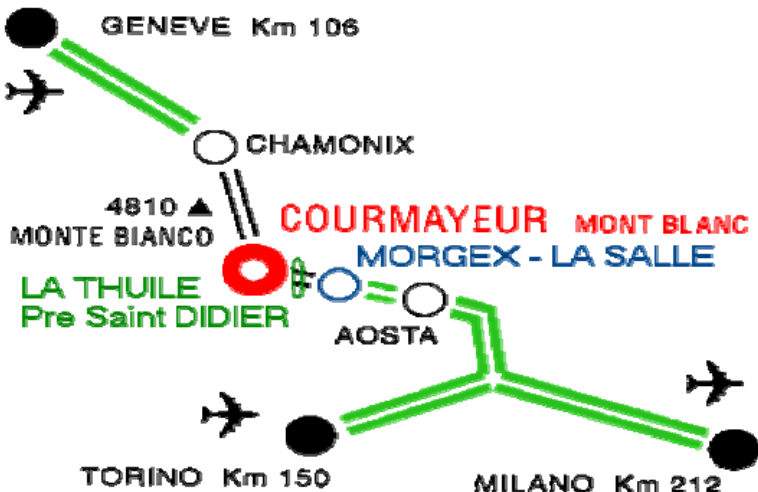
