Grindelwald, Switzerland

Grindelwald sits high above the town of Interlaken with the towering trio of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau as a breathtaking backdrop. It provides the perfect mix of pristine alpine skiing in the world-famous Jungfrau region with abundant sightseeing in the Bernese Oberland area. With Wengen and Mürren, there are 45 lifts and 125 miles of marked runs, all on the same lift pass and accessed by a remarkable high mountain train system. The aggressive downhiller will find his or her piece of heaven on World Cup downhill courses, and the off-piste deep powder hound will find runs through wide open bowls. Long cruising runs offer gentle alternatives for intermediate skiers. With a special Aktiv Pass, non-skiers can ride most of the lifts and all of the trains and enjoy many miles of prepared winter walking paths. Skiers and non-skiers alike will want to ride Europe's highest railway to the famous Jungfrauoch at 11,333 feet. On a clear day, the views are truly spectacular from this vantage point. From Interlaken, day trips to cities like Lucerne and Bern can be easily arranged. Our home for the week will be the elegant, 4-star Hotel Belvedere situated in the center of the resort. The hotel features a charming restaurant, bar (often with live band and dancing), lounge with fireplace, restaurant, pool, sauna, whirlpool, fitness room and sun terrace.

After our week in the Swiss Alps, we will board the train for a scenic journey to Amsterdam. This beautiful city could be a living 17th century museum, yet its architecture is harmoniously balanced with a very modern point of view. **Amsterdam** is an excellent city to tour on foot, and many sights await you - the Van Gogh Museum, the Rijksmuseum with one of the best Rembrandt collections in the world, Anne Frank's house, the Heineken Brewery, canals, gabled houses, the red light district, and more. We'll stay at the 4-star, Hotel AMS Lairesse, located close to all major museums and shopping streets.

TOUR DETAILS AND CONDITIONS

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENTS - A deposit of \$400 per person is due to hold your place on this tour. Upon receipt of payment, you will be sent an invoice and "Know Before You Go" information kit. Final payment is due **January 25, 2000**. Your place may be cancelled if payments are not received on time.

PRICING - The Ski Package price is based on a minimum group size of 20 participants. Should group size fall between 15 and 19 people, the package price will increase by \$50 per person. The Amsterdam Extension price is based on a minimum group size of 15 participants. Should group size fall between 10 and 14 people, the package price will increase by \$30 per person. Package price is subject to change due to airfare fuel surcharges, currency devaluations, general tariff increases, or for any other reason beyond the control of the tour operators. Tour is priced on exchange rates in effect as of April 1, 2000. Tour price includes reasonable charges for administration and planning of tour. In case of human or computer billing error, All Mountain Vacations reserves the right to reinvoice for the correct amount. *All prices reflect a cash discount.* For payments by Visa, Mastercard or American Express, add 3%.

EXCHANGE RATE INFORMATION

The U.S. dollar is currently enjoying an extremely favorable exchange rate with the European currencies and the Eurodollar. The pricing of this package reflects the strong value of the dollar. Forecasts indicate that the U.S. dollar will remain strong. However, in the event of a significant drop on the dollar's value, a surcharge will be applied to your package price.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT - Single rooms are limited and available on a first-come basis. For the Ski Package Only, add \$175. For Amsterdam, add \$240. Please be aware that single rooms tend to be quite small and may only contain one twin bed.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS - Group space in Tourist Class has been booked on SAS from Seattle for this departure. Departures from other cities or connecting flights are available, usually at a carrier add-on surcharge. Frequent flyer award holders can book their own air arrangements. You are responsible for arriving and departing at the same time as the group in order to use the group transfers. Unused transfers are non-refundable. Upgrades to Business Class are available. Ask for details. Airfares are subject to change by the airline for fuel and tax-related reasons.

DEVIATIONS AND EXTENSIONS - Deviations and extensions are allowed, depending on air space availability. In addition to any airfare increases/fees and extra land charges, a deviation fee of \$75 per person will be charged by All Mountain Vacations. Any unused portions of original package are non-refundable. Deviation and extension requests must be submitted prior to **January 10, 2000**. Once deviation itinerary has been confirmed, any subsequent changes will each be charged a \$35 fee, plus any additional air and land costs.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS - All cancellations in writing please. Prior to Sep. 1, 2000, forfeit \$25 per person. From Sep. 1—January 25: forfeit \$400 per person, unless a replacement is found. From January 25 until departure: Forfeit total land costs plus any airline charges unless refunds can be negotiated with hotels and airline.

TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE - Travel worry-free with Cancellation and Interruption Insurance. For only \$157 per person (Ski Pkg Only) or \$242 (Ski Pkg + Extension), you will receive a comprehensive insurance package that includes the following benefits: full reimbursement of all non-refundable payments made prior to departure if trip is cancelled for a medical reason, \$10,000 medical expense, \$20,000 emergency assistance, \$1000 lost baggage allowance, and more. All baggage is carried at owner's own risk. It is up to you to make claims with transportation and insurance companies involved. Insurance should be purchased with deposit for full value protection. **Pre-Existing Medical Conditions Exclusion Waived, if policy purchased within 7 days of initial trip deposit.** *For complete coverage details, please ask for a Travel Guard brochure.*



MILEAGE CREDIT - Mileage credit may be earned for your flights. You must be a member prior to checking in for the flight, and you must submit your mileage account number at check-in.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS - Seats are assigned on a first booked and request basis. Carriers will do their best to honor all requests. All flights are non-smoking.

BAGGAGE - Normal baggage allowance is two pieces per person, not to exceed 70 lbs each. A skier on an international flight is allowed to substitute 1 ski bag and 1 boot bag for one of the suitcases, for a total of three pieces of checked luggage. In addition, 1 carry-on bag is allowed, but it cannot exceed 15 lbs. in weight or 45 inches in total dimensions, and it must fit under your seat or in the overhead compartment. To exceed ski baggage allowance could cost approx. \$110 minimum each way per piece.

TOUR ESCORT - The tour will be escorted, but not necessarily on all flights. His and her primary concern is the group welfare. They will assist in tour-related and individual problems, but not at expense of group needs.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS - U.S. and Canadian citizens require a valid passport. Non-citizens please consult your consulate.

SKI PASS INFORMATION - A six-day Jungfrau Region ski pass costs approx. \$170. Passes of shorter duration and for smaller sections of the resort are available. Ski-Aktiv passes are also available for non-skiers, at a reduced price, enabling them to ride many of the trains and lifts in the region.

NOT INCLUDED - Lift passes, ski guides, services & meals not specified, portage at hotels, beverages at meals, tips to porters, drivers, hotel staff, or guides, items of a personal nature, & **air taxes of approx. \$70 per person.**

TIPPING - If you have received good service, it is customary to tip porters, drivers, guides, waitstaff and chambermaids at the end of your stay. Your tour escort will discuss details.
